To keep everyone as safe as possible the parish has to ensure that social distancing is maintained at all times. To this end a oneway system has been established within the church with separate entry and exit doors. The oneway system is signposted throughout the church and parishioners are required to follow the correct route at all times. To maintain the 2 metre separation required by social distancing only certain pews within the church can be used. The pews that can be used will be clearly signposted. To help and assist parishioners Volunteer stewards are present in the church at all times that it is open.
