Prayer for Spiritual Communion



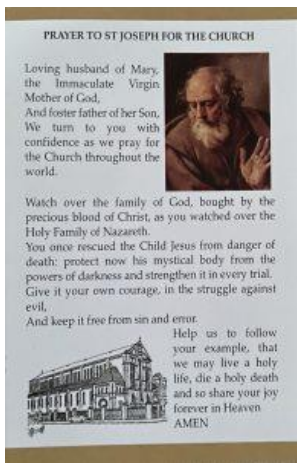
