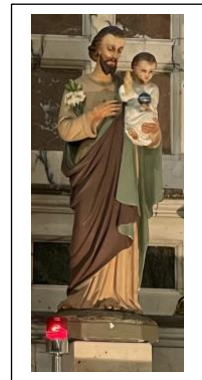

Church Ceiling

Thank you to all who have already donated. You may have noticed the paint on the church ceiling has started to peel off in small parts. I am told that this is not about water penetration but most probably due to the age of the paint. An exception to this is the part of the ceiling above the organ loft. Immediately above the organ, some of the plasterwork has started to crumble and fall. This will need to be addressed immediately because of the possibility of damage to the organ. The total cost should be around £8000. If anyone can make a contribution towards this work, would they please speak to Monsignor Bradley.
